Connecting through Signs and Building Understanding

Understanding develops before ability to express How to teach signs to build understanding?

- Repeating is teaching!
- Model consistently
- Combine sign with spoken word
- Choose meaningful signs for meaningful moments

But when will my baby use signs?

- When your baby is ready!
- Using signs and words is more complex
 - Cognition, motor control, motivation
- You can help your baby get ready by building the communication connection
 - Respond to sounds & gestures your baby makes ... not just the one you're expecting
 - Could be a **sign approximation** if motion too complex, that's ok!
 - Take a turn give a turn by waiting
 - Observe your baby's interests what is motivating?

Try these 6 Functional Signs we practiced in class:

- 1 More
- 2. All done ** in the book it says "finished"
- 3. Milk
- Eat
 Potty
- 6. Help

Or any signs that are meaningful for your family

When you practice:

- Repeat, repeat, repeat
- Use gesture + word
- Model consistently to support understanding
- Have fun!
