

- Over 1 million immigrants every year



#### **Current Enforcement Statistics:**

- Number of persons in ICE detention: 59,762
- 71.5% of current detainees have no criminal convictions
- Number of persons arrested by ICE in September: 24,755
- 22% of persons are detained in Texas
- Approximately 85% arrests in Sept. were conducted in the interior of the country by ICE

### What is a "Sanctuary" City or State?


- No set legal definition
- Symbolic statement: immigrants are "safe" in that city because local police limit cooperation with ICE
- Some cities have different additional "sanctuary" policies

ICE can still come to a sanctuary locality and conduct raids,

arrests, etc.

- Received green card in 1986 through special program




## Cleto "Sundy" Chazares


