

Need help finding food?

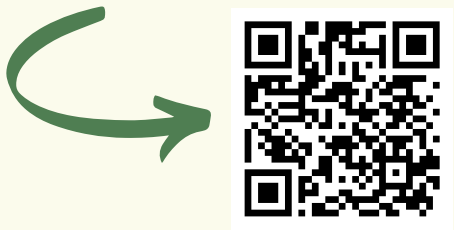
Navigating local food resources can be challenging—hours change, locations vary, and information isn't always up to date.

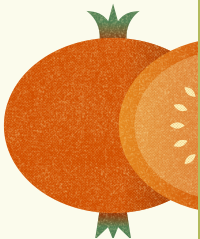
