## How can my child get a library card through their school or camp?

1. Complete the enclosed application (front and back).
2. Include your Driver License number (if available).
3. Return the application to your child's camp counselor or teacher.

The camp or school will then verify the information is accurate.

**Applications must be signed by a parent or legal guardian.**

The Library will process your application and mail your child's card to the address provided on the application.

Library cards may also be obtained by returning completed applications to the Circulation Desk. A parent or guardian with proof of address must be present for children under 13.
