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NOTES ON THE INDEX

This index is an alphabetized list of obituaries and death notices which appeared in the principal newspaper of Ithaca, New York, during the years 1875 and 1876. During this period the newspaper was a daily publication four pages long. The index was compiled from microfilms in Olin Library, Cornell University, of the daily issues from January 1, 1875 through December 1876.

The name of the deceased person is followed by the age at death and the date of death, when available; the date of the death notice; and some explanatory notes. The last name of the deceased is followed by the given names and often by a title such as Mrs., Miss, Hon., Prof., Dr., Rev., etc. For some entries only the last name is available.

Death notices usually appeared on page 4. Occasionally, however, they are found on page 1 or on page 3; when this is the case it is indicated in the notes.

The surname of the deceased was sometimes spelled in different ways in successive entries or even in the same entry. When it was impossible to be sure which spelling was correct, both spellings have been listed, the more dubious one in parentheses.

About 40 per cent of the entries came from the official death notices. The remainder came from news items, especially from neighboring towns, or from legal notices and reports of surrogate's court proceedings.

The term "legal notice" in the notes indicates a notice to creditors of the deceased to file their claims against the estate. Such a notice gives the name and place of residence of the deceased, but little other information except the names of the executors or administrators. Surrogate court proceedings (listed as "Surrog. Ct. proc.") record actions relating to the sale of property and estate distribution. They often list the heirs and sometimes their relationship to the deceased.

Following the main index is an alphabetical list of cross-references showing the names of relatives of the deceased, most commonly the father or parents of a married woman.

Finally there is an analysis of the ages at death. Of the 955 names in the main list (568 men, 375 women, 12 children for whom the gender was not given), ages were given for 622 (363 men, 259 women). The analysis shows the number of deaths at each age. There were three centenarians, two women and one man. The man, Dalle Vallemain, a Frenchman, was said to have died at age 112.

The average and median ages at death of those for whom the age is given are listed below. Included for comparison are the averages and medians from the *Ithaca Journal* for the year 1996.
