UNITED STATES COPYRIGHT LAW

In force July 7, 1909

Section 28. That any person who wilfully and for profit shall infringe any copyright secured by this act or who shall knowingly or wilfully aid or abet such infringement, shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction thereof shall be punished by imprisonment for not exceeding one year or by a fine of not less than one hundred dollars, nor more than one thousand dollars, or both in the discretion of the court.

LOCATION—The City of Ithaca, located in the heart of the Finger Lakes Legion of Central New York State at the head of beautiful Cayuga Lake, is famous for four things:

1. Its educational institutions
2. Its position as the agricultural center of the northeast United States
3. Its rugged and picturesque scenic beauty, and
4. Its many progressive small industries.

Known far and wide as the home of Cornell University and Ithaca College, Ithaca is noted for its culture and refined atmosphere in all activities of business and social life.

Its latitude is 42° 27' north and its longitude is 76° 29' west. Located in the center of Western New York State, it is 240 miles south to New York City; Boston is 400 miles east, Albany 175 miles east, Buffalo is 150 miles west, Elmira 35 miles south, Syracuse 55 miles northeast and Rochester 88 miles northwest.

TOPOGRAPHY—Ithaca is in a land of lakes and hills, deep ravines and towering cliffs, waterfalls and cataracts. The city itself is bordered on three sides by hills cut through by the deep gorges of Six Mile, Cascadilla and Fall Creeks which abound with cascades and waterfalls, and on the fourth side by Cayuga Lake, all providing a most picturesque setting. Climate ranges in temperature from an average minimum of 26° to an average maximum of 69°. This comparatively close range of minimum and maximum temperatures results from Ithaca's enviable position on at the head of 40-mile long Cayuga Lake. The elevation of the lake, the lowest point in the city is 383 feet above sea level and Cornell University Campus, the highest part of the city, is approximately 800 feet above sea level.

HISTORICAL—Ithaca was settled in 1789, ten years after the visit of a detachment of 200 men commanded by Col. Dearborn from the expeditionary force of General Sullivan first visited the area on September 23, 1779. It was named Ithaca by Simeon DeWitt, Surveyor General under Washington in 1795 after the ancient Greek capitol of Ithaca. It was incorporated as a village in 1821, chartered as a city in 1888 and has been the county seat of Tompkins County since the county's formation in 1818. In days long gone past, Ithaca was a center of inland water transportation as well as the salt center of New York State. Ithaca celebrated in 1939 its 150th Anniversary.

POPULATION—In January 1955 the population of Ithaca was established at 31,500. This figure includes the students of Ithaca College and Cornell residing within the city limits. The permanent year

around population figure is estimated as 26,245, a gain of 3,700 in 10 years. In 1925 the population was 18,948. In 1920 it was 17,004; 1910, 14,802; 1900, 13,136 and 1890, 11,072.

There are about 87.4% native born white population, about 3% colored and 10% foreign born.

Ithaca has more than 7,292 homes, over half of which are owned by the occupants. There are 2,889 single dwellings and 4,403 double dwellings.

MERCANTILE—Ithaca is a trading center of some 70,000 persons and has stores comparable with those of cities much larger. Because of the University population and a community educated to want the best, retail stores carry merchandise equal in variety and quality to stores in leading eastern cities. There are over 430 retail stores, employing over 2,510 persons with annual sales in excess of \$52,304,000. There are also over 38 wholesale houses employing 298 with annual sales of \$17,374,000. About 138 service trade establishments, doing an annual business of \$2,635,000 and employing 414 persons are also located in Ithaca. There are 274 professional offices located within the city limits.

Per capita retail sales in Ithaca were 90% above the U. S. average in 1953. The average Ithaca household has a net income of \$7,145 which is 36% higher than the national average.



INDUSTRIAL PLANT

INDUSTRIAL—Although Ithaca is not primarily an industrial city, it has sixteen industries with an employment figure in excess of 3,882; a payroll totalling \$12,679,000 and a total value of products amounting to \$29,827,000. Cornell University employs 4,450 and Ithaca College 168, while G. L. F. (Grange League Federation) has 500 employees and the New York State Electric & Gas Corporation 447.

Among the principal products manufactured here are: adding machines, shotguns, power drive chains, leather goods, rayon and cotton underwear, lantern slides, technical mirrors, precision instruments, pottery, salt, photo engraving, detergents, woodworking and dairy products.

Ithaca has an unusually intelligent class of workmen. Educational advantages for industrial workers and their families include a liberal policy provision for vocational education and training in public schools.

There are sites available for industrial development and several organizations are active in the promotion of industrial expansion within the Ithaca trading area. Inquiries addressed to the Ithaca Chamber of Commerce will bring a prompt reply.



CORNELL STUDENTS AT WORK

EDUCATIONAL—Ithaca is among the leading educational centers of the state. There are 10 public schools and one parochial school. The school enrollment is 4,600 with 194 teachers and administrative staff. Cornell University, which is one of the great universities of North America, located on one of America's most beautiful campus overlooking the lower parts of the city and Lake Cayuga, was founded in 1865 by Ezra Cornell. The normal enrollment is about 10,000 students. The university includes colleges of Art and Science, Medicine, Law, Engineering, Architecture, the State College of Agriculture, Veterinary Medicine, Industrial and Labor Relations, Home Economics, a Graduate School a School of Hotel Management, Education, Nursing, Nutrition and Business and Public Administration. It occupies about 7,000 acres of land and 155 buildings, which with their equipment are valued at about \$35,000,000 while endowment add about \$42,000,000 more to the resources of the institutions. There are also located in the city Ithaca College, devoted to music, drama and physical education; the Cascadilla Tutoring School. There are four libraries, as follows: Cornell Library is located in the heart of the business district and gives an extensive service to the public; the Cornell University Library located on the campus has over 825,000 volumes including special collections having international fame; the Tompkins County Bar Association Library is located in Ithaca Savings Bank Building; the Free Library maintained by the H. A. Manning Co. of N. Y. in the Chamber of Commerce Rooms at 114 North Aurora St.

FINANCIAL—Ithaca has 3 banks with total deposits of about \$50,000,000 and one savings and loan association. These banks are well housed and progressive and have grown with the city. The per capita wealth is high. Ithaca rated third in New York State in 1950. The net taxable value of city property was \$40,564,250 in 1954. The real value of city property totals \$81,370,475. The city government

has operated within its budget for the past 31 years, has a low bonded indebtedness and the highest financial rating. The tax rate is \$16.80 per \$1,000. Postal receipts in 1954 totaled \$904,438.95, an unusually high figure for a city the size of Ithaca.

PARKS, PLAYGROUNDS AND POINTS OF INTEREST—The natural topography of the land here makes the city a natural park. There are three public parks within the city, the largest of which is located at the lake end of the city and has recreation and athletic facilities also an extensive bathing beach on Lake Cayuga. The Cornell Campus is extensive and supplies a very beautiful park-like effect for the upper part of the city. The following scenic beauty spots in and not far from the city are: Buttermilk Falls State Park, Cascadilla Glen, Cayuga Lake, Coys Glen, Robert H. Treman State Park, Fall Creek Gorge, Ithaca Gorge and Falls, Point Lookout, Taughannock Falls State Park, Watkins Glen State Park.

TRANSPORTATION—Ithaca is the home base of Mohawk Airlines Inc., operating from the East Hill Airport, largest of the city's two airports, providing direct air passenger, mail and cargo service to 23 New York State communities, 6 in Massachusetts, as well as to New Jersey and New Hampshire. The Ithaca Municipal Airport, only three miles from the heart of the business section, is the second oldest in the state. Ithaca is the hub of a network of highways that make travel in central western New York State a tourist's dream. Ithaca is likewise served by the main line of the Lehigh Valley Railroad as well as branch lines and the Ithaca-Owego branch of the D. L. & W. Railroad. The Ithaca Railway

Inc., operates a modern bus service serving the entire city and surrounding suburbs. The city bus terminal on South Aurora Street provides a terminus for interurban buses from Elmira, Watkins Glen, Binghamton, Cortland, Syracuse, Rochester, New York, Auburn, etc.

Ithaca is also the southern terminal of the New York Barge Canal system and is provided with docking facilities for boats operating on the canal. Several hundred pleasure crafts including the larger motor cruisers have Ithaca as their home port. Several large boatyards provide sheltered waters and cover for boats whose valuation approximates a quarter million dollars owned by persons from the surrounding area and cities as far away as Elmira, Binghamton, Owego and Scranton.

Daily trucking service is provided to all business in the area by numerous motor truck freight lines.

MISCELLANEOUS STATISTICS—Ithaca is the center of agricultural activity in the Northeastern United States. Here are located the offices of the G. L. F. (farmer's co-operative), Farm Bureau Federation and many other organizations of great importance to rural interests. Gross income from farm products sold in Tompkins County in 1954 totalled about \$10,242,000 with another \$7,790,000 grossed

from the sale of livestock and livestock products. Ithaca has a very active fraternal, club and social life with almost 200 organizations listed. A sports loving community, the city has 3 golf courses, 14 parks and playgrounds, public bathing beach, municipal tennis courts, and a year-round youth recreation program with a paid director. Tens of thousands of sports lovers are annually attracted to Ithaca

College and Cornell University sports events. There are 5 hospitals with 653 beds; seven theatres seating 8,152; police department with 37 men; fire department housed in 5 stations and operating ten pieces of equipment; 21 churches and 10 hotels with 576 rooms. The Chamber of Commerce has recently surveyed the entire area for rooming accommodations for conventions and other large gatherings and has lists available for those interested. There were 18,343 passenger cars registered in 1955; 8,760 gas meters; 24,622 electric meters and 29,529 telephones. Building permits issued in 1950 totalled 210 valued at \$500,000. The water storage capacity is 350,000,000 with a daily pump of over 3,000,000. Almost 52,600 pounds of air mail moved through the Ithaca Post Office in 1954.
