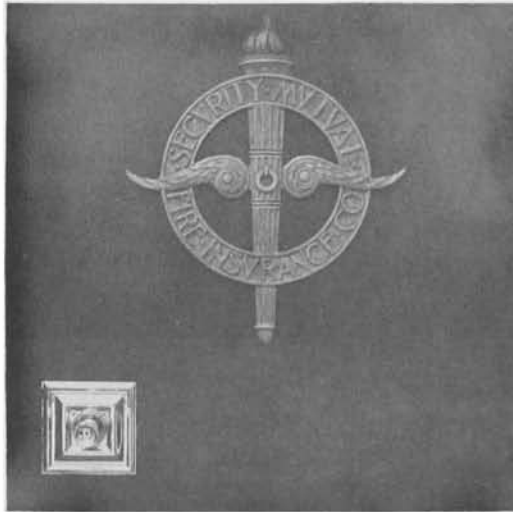

INTRODUCTION & GENERAL INDEX

H. A. MANNING CO., publishers of Directories for over 300 Communities, present to subscribers and the general public, the 1966 edition of the City Directory.

Confidence in the continued growth, industry, population and wealth, and in the advancement of its civic and social activities, will be maintained as sections of this Directory are consulted, for the Directory is a mirror truly reflecting the community to the world.

The position occupied by MANNING'S Directories in the estimation of the public throughout the country, has been established by rendering the best in Directory service, with an experienced organization, and having had the courteous and hearty co-operation of the business and professional men and residents, the publishers feel that the result of their labors will meet with the approval of every user, and that the Directory will fulfill its mission as a source of authentic information pertaining to the city.

FIVE MAJOR DEPARTMENTS

The five major departments are arranged in the following order:—

I. THE DESCRIPTIVE SECTION is the first major department printed on white paper: information about statistical review, historical sketch, manufacturing, trade and civic surveys, indexes, and deluxe advertising.

II. THE YELLOW PAGES constitute the second major department of the Directory. This embraces the **only complete list** of the names and addresses of the business and professional concerns of the city, arranged in alphabetical order under appropriate headings — a catalog of all the activities of the city. Preceding this catalog, likewise grouped under appropriate headings, are the advertisements and business cards of firms and individuals desiring to present a more complete list of their products or services than is possible in the catalog itself. The Yellow Pages represent reference advertising at its best, and merit the attention of all buyers and sellers seeking sources of supply or markets for goods. In a busy and diversified community the necessity of having this kind of information up-to-date and always immediately available, is obvious.

III. THE ALPHABETICAL LIST OF NAMES of residents and business and professional concerns is the third major department printed on white paper. This is the only record in existence that aims to show the name, marital status, occupation and address of each adult resident, and the name, official personnel, nature and address of each firm, corporation and organization in the city.

IV. THE DIRECTORY OF HOUSEHOLDERS, INCLUDING STREET AND AVENUE GUIDE, on pink paper, is the fourth major department. In this section the streets are arranged in alphabetical order: the numbers of the residences and business concerns are arranged in numerical order under the name of each street, and the names of the householders and concerns are placed opposite the numbers. The names of the intersecting streets appear at their respective crossing points on each street. Special features of this section are the designation of tenant-owned homes, the indication of telephone subscribers at homes and places of business, and the number in the family.

V. THE NUMERICAL TELEPHONE LOCATER, on green paper, is the fifth major department. All listed phones for the area are arranged by exchanges and under each exchange, in numerical order with the name of the phone holder indicated.

COMMUNITY PUBLICITY — The Directory reflects the achievements and ambitions of the city, depicting in unbiased terms what it has to offer as a place of residence, as a business location, as a manufacturing site and as an educational center. To broadcast this information, the publishers have placed copies of this issue of the Directory in Directory Libraries, where they are readily available for free public reference, and serve as perpetual and reliable advertisements.

The publishers appreciatively acknowledge the recognition by those progressive business and professional men who have demonstrated their confidence in the City Directory as an advertising medium and community service.

The local resident, the visitor, and the distant reader about Ithaca wish to gain an impression of Ithaca as well as to have at hand a statistical reference regarding the city and its people. It is the publishers' aim to portray as much of Ithaca's charm and greatness as is consistent with facts. The teachings of the City Map and the City Directory about localities, districts, street locations, street changes, growth of sections and general city changes are of great importance to property owners, old residents, new residents and school children. Racial characteristics of names in the Directory enable the consultant to gain a very comprehensive knowledge of the inhabitants of the city and many other educational facts. Notable men all through history have contributed their philosophy as to the value of knowledge about the home town. Here is one from Abraham Lincoln: "I like to see a man proud of the place in which he lives. I like to see a man live so that his place will be proud of him." In studying the following, remember that the Ithaca City Directory disseminates this information far and wide where this Directory represents Ithaca in the Free Directory Library Exchange System of North America. The Ithaca City Directory, with over 500 closely printed pages, is the City of Ithaca in book form; its family and social life, business and industrial life is portrayed in great detail. The publishers invite and accept constructive criticism and suggestions for the improvement of the Directory for the benefit of Ithaca and all interested.

LOCATION—The City of Ithaca, located in the heart of the Finger Lakes Region of Central New York State at the head of beautiful Cayuga Lake, is famous for four things:

1. Its educational institutions
2. Its position as the agricultural center of the northeast United States
3. Its rugged and picturesque scenic beauty, and
4. Its many progressive small industries.

Known far and wide as the home of Cornell University and Ithaca College, Ithaca is noted for its culture and refined atmosphere in all activities of business and social life.

Its latitude is 42° 27' north and its longitude is 76° 29' west. Located in the center of the Southern Tier of New York State, it is 240 miles south to New York City; Boston is 350 miles east, Albany 175 miles east, Buffalo is 150 miles west, Elmira 35 miles south, Binghamton 50 miles southeast, Syracuse 55 miles northeast and Rochester 88 miles northwest.

TOPOGRAPHY—Ithaca is in a land of lakes and hills, deep ravines and towering cliffs, waterfalls and cataracts. The city itself is bordered on three sides by hills cut through by the deep gorges of Six Mile, Cascadilla and Fall Creeks which abound with cascades and waterfalls, and on the fourth side by Cayuga Lake, all providing a most picturesque setting. Climate ranges in temperature from an average minimum of 26° to an average maximum of 69°. This comparatively close range of minimum and maximum temperatures results from Ithaca's enviable position at the head of 40-mile long Cayuga Lake. The elevation of the lake, the lowest point in the city is 383 feet above sea level and Cornell University Campus, the highest part of the city, is approximately 800 feet above sea level.

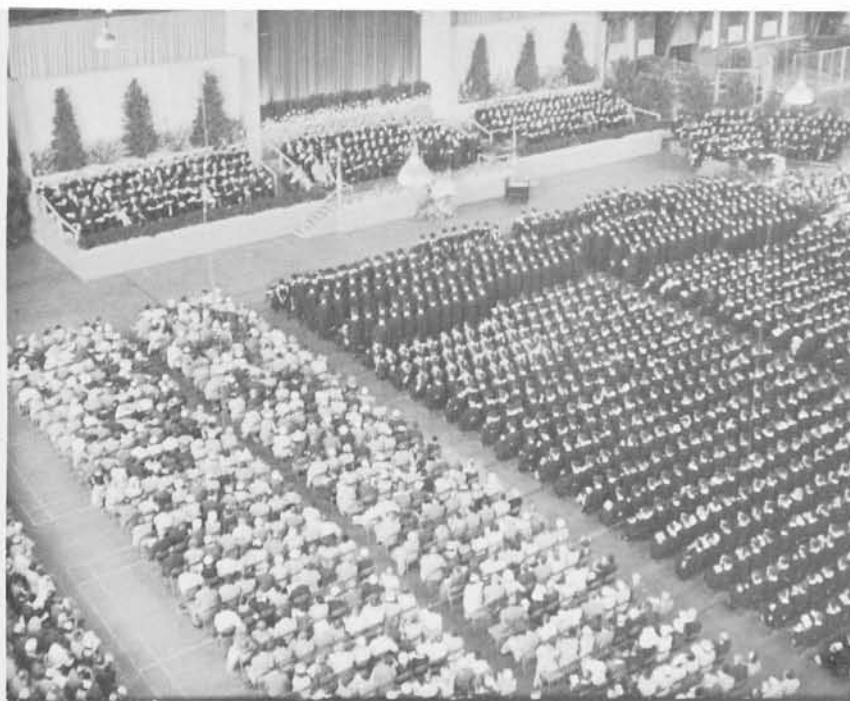

HISTORICAL—Ithaca was settled in 1789, ten years after the visit of a detachment of 200 men commanded by Col. Dearborn from the expeditionary force of General Sullivan first visited the area on September 23, 1779. It was named Ithaca by Simeon DeWitt, Surveyor General under Washington in 1795 after the ancient Greek capitol of Ithaca. It was incorporated as a village in 1821, chartered as a city in 1888 and has been the county seat of Tompkins County since the county's formation in 1818. In days long gone past, Ithaca was a center of inland water transportation as well as the salt center of New York State. Ithaca celebrated in 1939 its 150th Anniversary.

POPULATION—Ithaca's metropolitan area, has a population, according to the 1960 federal census of 44,614. This includes the City of Ithaca, 28,744, Village of Cayuga Heights, 3,104, Ithaca Township, 9,411, and the students at Cornell University and Ithaca College. As in many communities, extensive growth has been seen in the population outside the central city. Between 1900 and 1950 the city population increased from 13,150 to 19,800 or 65%. The town and village during the same period increased from 1,600 to 8,600 or 540%. The student population in 1900 was slightly less than 3,000, today there are nearly 15,000.

Ithaca's population is about 87% native born white, about 3% colored and 10% foreign born.

Ithaca in 1960 had 8,220 homes with 45.3% owner occupied.

Tompkins County in 1960 had 66,164 inhabitants. This figure includes students.

MERCANTILE—Ithaca is a trading center of some 100,000 persons and has stores comparable with those of cities much larger. Because of the University population and a community educated to want the best, retail stores carry merchandise equal in variety and quality to stores in leading eastern cities. There are over 450 retail stores, employing over 2,500 persons with annual sales in excess of \$60,000,000. There are also over 46 wholesale houses employing over 400 with annual sales of \$24,000,000. About 200 service trade establishments, doing an annual business of \$6,000,000 and employing over 800 persons are also located in Ithaca. There are about 300 professional offices located within the city limits.

INDUSTRIAL—Although Ithaca is not primarily an industrial city, it has 42 manufacturing establishments with an employment figure in excess of 5,000; a payroll totaling over \$19,500,000 and a total value added by manufacture of \$15,967,000. Cornell University employs 6,500 and Ithaca College 250, and the New York State Electric & Gas Corporation 550.

Among the principal products manufactured here are: adding machines, shotguns, power drive chains, rayon and cotton underwear, lantern slides, technical mirrors, precision machine tools, scientific instruments, salt, photo engraving, books, magazines, detergents, woodworking, and dairy products.

Ithaca has an unusually intelligent class of workmen. Educational advantages for industrial workers and their families include a liberal policy provision for vocational education and training in public schools.

Ithaca has been developing also as a research center.

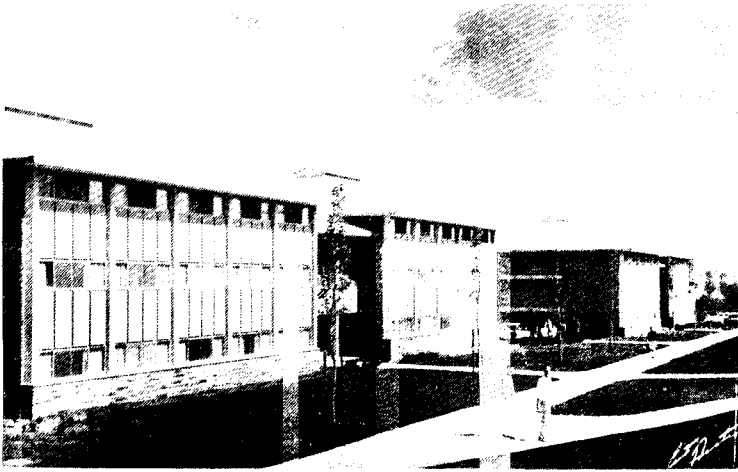


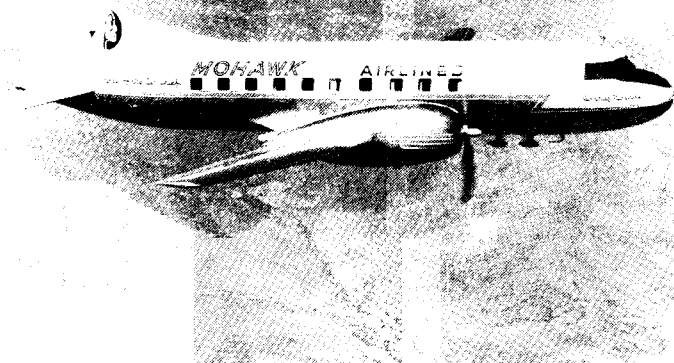

EDUCATIONAL—Ithaca is among the leading educational centers of the state. The Ithaca enlarged City School District includes 15 public schools with an enrollment of 6,600 and a staff of 320 teachers and administrators. The District covers 160 square miles. There are two junior high schools, and Ithaca now boasts one of the newest, most modern high schools in the state, opened in 1959 at a new site. There is one parochial school in Ithaca providing classes from Kindergarten through eighth grade.

Cornell University, which is one of the great universities of North America, located on one of America's most beautiful campuses overlooking the lower parts of the city and Lake Cayuga, was founded in 1865 by Ezra Cornell. The normal enrollment is about 12,000 students. The university includes colleges of Art and Science, Medicine, Law, Engineering, Architecture, the State College of Agriculture, Veterinary Medicine, Industrial and Labor Relations, Home Economics, a Graduate School, a School of Hotel Management, Education, Nursing, Nutrition and Business and Public Administration. It occupies about 7,000 acres of land and 155 buildings, which with their equipment are valued at about \$35,000,000 while endowment add about \$42,000,000 more to the resources of the institutions. There are also located in the city Ithaca College, devoted to music, drama and physical education; the Cascadilla Tutoring School. Ithaca College, with its present quarters in downtown Ithaca, has entered into a \$15,000,000 construction program. This entails the building of complete new facilities on Ithaca's South Hill. The campus site covers some 208 acres. There are five libraries, as follows: Cornell Public Library is located in the heart of the business district and gives an extensive service to the public; the Cornell University Library located on the campus has over 825,000 volumes including special collections having international fame; the Ithaca College Library; the Tompkins County Bar Association Library is located in Ithaca Savings Bank Building; the Free Directory Library maintained by the H. A. Manning Co. of N. Y. in the Chamber of Commerce Rooms at 205 West Green St. Also at Cornell University are the specialized libraries of Agriculture, Industrial and Labor Relations, Engineering and Law. A five million dollar Research Library has just opened at Cornell.

FINANCIAL—Ithaca has two commercial banks: one savings bank and one savings and loan association, and 2 small loan financing companies. These banks are well housed and progressive and have grown with the city. The per capita wealth is high. Ithaca rated third in New York State in 1950. The net taxable value of city property was \$80,707,893 in 1961. The real value of city property totals \$163,707,893. The city government has operated within its budget for the past 35 years, has a low bonded indebtedness and the highest financial rating. The Tax equalization rate is 76% and the total tax rate per thousand at equalization rate is \$41.87.

TRANSPORTATION — Ithaca is served by Mohawk Airlines, Inc., which operates from the Tompkins County Airport, largest of the city's two airports, providing direct air passenger, mail and cargo service to 23 New York State communities, 6 in Massachusetts, as well as to New Jersey, New Hampshire and Detroit, Michigan, also Empire Airlines serving Elmira, Binghamton, Albany, New York City and Washington, D. C. The Ithaca Municipal Airport, only three miles from the heart of the business section, is the second oldest in the state. Ithaca is the hub of a network of highways that make travel in central western New York State a tourist's dream. The city operates the Community Transit System serving the entire city and surrounding suburbs. Ithaca is served by the Greyhound Bus Line and provides a terminus for interurban buses from Elmira, Watkins Glen, Binghamton, Owego, Cortland, Syracuse, Rochester, New York City, etc.

Ithaca is also the southern terminal of the New York Barge Canal system and is provided with docking facilities for boats operating on the canal. Several hundred pleasure crafts including the larger motor cruisers have Ithaca as their home port. Several large boatyards provide sheltered waters and cover for boats whose valuation approximates a quarter million dollars owned by persons from the surrounding area and cities as far away as Elmira, Binghamton, Owego and Scranton. A new City Airport and Marina was opened in 1960 and provides recreation and boating marina with spaces for 104 boats.

Daily trucking service is provided to all business in the area by numerous motor truck freight lines.

PARKS, PLAYGROUNDS AND BOAT-

ING—The natural topography of the land here makes the city a natural park. There are three public parks within the city, the largest of which is located at the lake end of the city and has recreation and athletic facilities also an extensive bathing beach on Lake Cayuga. The Cornell Campus is extensive and supplies a very beautiful park-like effect for the upper part of the city. The following scenic beauty spots in and not far from the city are: Buttermilk Falls State Park, Cascadilla Glen, Cayuga Lake, Coys Glen, Robert H. Treman State Park, Fall Creek Gorge, Ithaca Gorge and Falls, Point Lookout, Taughannock Falls State Park, Watkins Glen State Park.

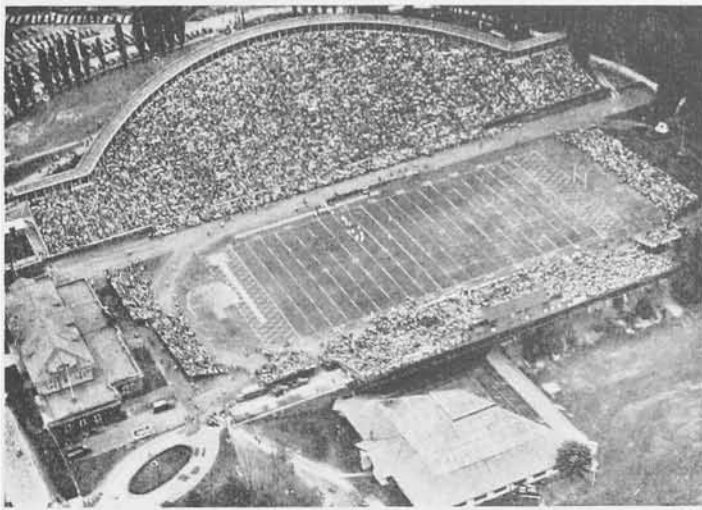


Cayuga Lake

Ithaca and Cayuga Lake have become the headquarters for small boating enthusiasts throughout the Southern Tier of New York State and much of north central Pennsylvania. Each year more and more boats are brought to Cayuga Lake. In 1957, it was estimated that over \$1,000,000 worth of pleasure crafts made Ithaca their "home port." In addition, hundreds of transient boats visit Ithaca each year using both the public and private launching and docking facilities. Water skiing is rapidly becoming a popular sport on Cayuga Lake.

Detailed information on the recreation facilities of the Ithaca area can be secured from the Ithaca Chamber of Commerce.

SPORTING EVENTS—A wealth of both spectator and participation sporting events may be found in the Ithaca area. There are four golf courses, bowling, swimming, tennis, archery, and many other sports facilities are available. The recently completed Lynah Ice Rink at Cornell University is open to the public for skating. Football, ice hockey, crew, baseball, and polo are only a few of the many sporting events taking place in Ithaca on a year-round schedule.

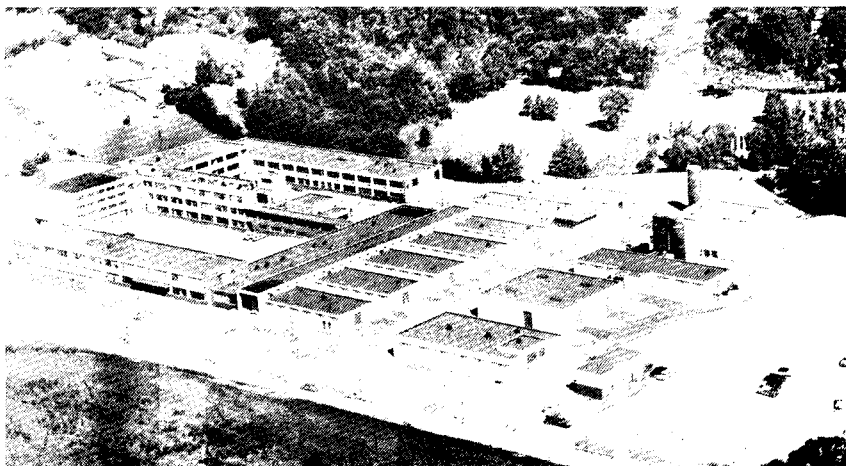
Block Printing — York State Craft Fair

SPECIAL EVENTS AND INTERESTING FACTS—Ithaca is the headquarters of the York State Craftsmen and each year during August the York State Craft Fair is presented. The fair features both displays and demonstrations.

Known as the center of agriculture activity in Northeastern United States, Ithaca is the home of the New York State College of Agriculture, Cooperative Grange League Federation Exchange, Inc., Empire Livestock Marketing Cooperative, New York Artificial Breeders Cooperative, and many other organizations of great importance to rural interests. Cornell University's annual Agricultural Progress Days each year are a highlight even of our agricultural community.

Ithaca has very active fraternal, club and social life with over 200 organizations listed, there are 6 hospitals with nearly 500 beds. 4 theatres with a capacity of 4,800, five auditoriums with a capacity of 5,200, 21 churches covering nearly every major denomination and 16 hotels and motels, plus many fine tourist homes. Listings of accommodations are available at the Chamber of Commerce.

In 1961, there were 21,162 passenger cars registered and 25,948 electric meters, 10,263 gas meters, and 23,092 telephones in use. The Postal Receipts amounted to \$927,700 and airmail poundage amounted to 51,700 pounds. The city's water storage capacity (not connected with Lake Cayuga) is 350,000,000 gal. with a daily pump of over 3,000,000.

INDUSTRIAL — Although Ithaca is not primarily an industrial city, it has 42 manufacturing establishments with an employment figure in excess of 4,300; a payroll totaling over \$17,500,000 and a total value added by manufacture of \$15,967,000. Cornell University employs 5,800 and Ithaca College 175, and the New York State Electric & Gas Corporation 447.

Among the principle products manufactured here are: adding machines, shotguns, power drive chains, rayon and cotton underwear, lantern slides, technical mirrors, precision machine tools, scientific instruments, salt, photo engraving, books, magazines, detergents, woodworking and dairy products.

Ithaca has an unusually intelligent class of workmen. Educational advantages for industrial workers and their families include a liberal policy provision for vocational education and training in public schools.

Ithaca has been developing also as a research center. The General Electric Company established a "center" in Ithaca several years ago.

In 1965 the latest method of automated handling of data was installed at Bellows Falls division office which use "Variety" Line Composers with IBM cards for composition and proofreading of all directory text. These cards, after sequential sorting to the various directory sections, are photographed at 7,200 cards an hour on a "Fotolist" camera and processed in a developing machine producing negatives or direct-image copy for printing plate use.



Among the many applications for which these machines can be used besides directories are voting lists, mailing lists, price and parts lists, phone books and any type of lists which are periodically updated and printed.

The application of this new system will enhance the appearance and readability of our directories and outside services, improve on their accuracy and enable the enlargement of their basic overall directory service, outside contracting and employment opportunities.
